

Industrial Mathematics - UK best practice in Poland (18/11/2008)

The British Embassy hosted a seminar "Industrial Mathematics - UK best practice in Poland" organised together with the CambridgePYTHON project team on 17 November. Over 100 representatives of academic world, business and industry took part in the seminar.

Among the speakers were Paul Fox, EU/Commercial Counsellor, Consul General and Prof. Michał Kleiber, President of the Polish Academy of Sciences. Honorary guest of the event was Prof. John Ockendon from Oxford University, who gave a speech on interplay between business and academia.



The aim of the seminar was to present the processes that have been applied to migrating the British know-how of Industrial Mathematics to Poland. The results of the 4th Summer Research Practices organised by the Systems Research Institute, Polish Academy of Sciences (PAS), Institute of Mathematics PAS and WSISiZ Warsaw Information Technology were also presented.

Using the best British examples, Summer Research Practices promote within Poland the collaboration between academia and industry willing to improve its products and services by means of mathematics and information technology.
